Lodging Nominations

Nominations open on 7/11/2025 and must reach the Returning Officer, Jackie McHenry not later than the time stipulated at the Federal Council Meeting on 21/11/2025.

The Federal Council Meeting will be held at the PSA Office, 160 Clarence St, Sydney on Friday 21 November 2025 commencing at 9.00am.

Prospective candidates and nominators should verify their financial status and any other qualifications required by the Organisation's rules prior to lodging nominations.

Nominations must be lodged via the following method(s):

By Email: A properly completed nomination form including all necessary signatures and attachments may be scanned and submitted as a pdf file to lEBnominations@aec.gov.au. **The subject line of your email should include:** "E2024/17 Stage 2 – CPSU SPSF Group - Your Name"

In Person: At the Federal Council Meeting on 21/11/2025.

PLEASE NOTE:

- 1. Emails to the AEC inbox that appear to be spam may be blocked. It is the responsibility of senders to ensure that their email reaches the AEC before the deadline for nominations.
- 2. In order to be able to be received by the AEC, emails (including attachments) should be no greater than 6 MB in size.
- 3. Following the close of nominations, all nominations will undergo eligibility checks to determine if they are complete and all rule requirements are met. Where an issue has been identified the Returning Officer will advise the candidate and provide an opportunity to remedy the defect within a specified period.
- 4. The Returning Officer will notify all candidates of the outcome of the eligibility checks when the nominations accepted report is issued.

Withdrawal of Nominations

Nominations can be withdrawn any time prior to the printing of the ballot papers for any contested offices.

Voting Period

The Attendance Ballot, if required, will open on 21/11/2025 at the Federal Council Meeting at 160 Clarence St, Sydney at a time specified by the Returning Officer.

If an absent voting application is received, the ballot will open on 21/11/2025 and will close at 10.00am (AEDT) on 19/12/2025.

As per rule 37.3 c) if all the absent ballot packs are returned before the expiration of the ballot period, the Returning Officer may count the ballot immediately. Accordingly, should there be absent votes, once all ballots are returning, the Returning Officer will advise of the revised date of the count.
